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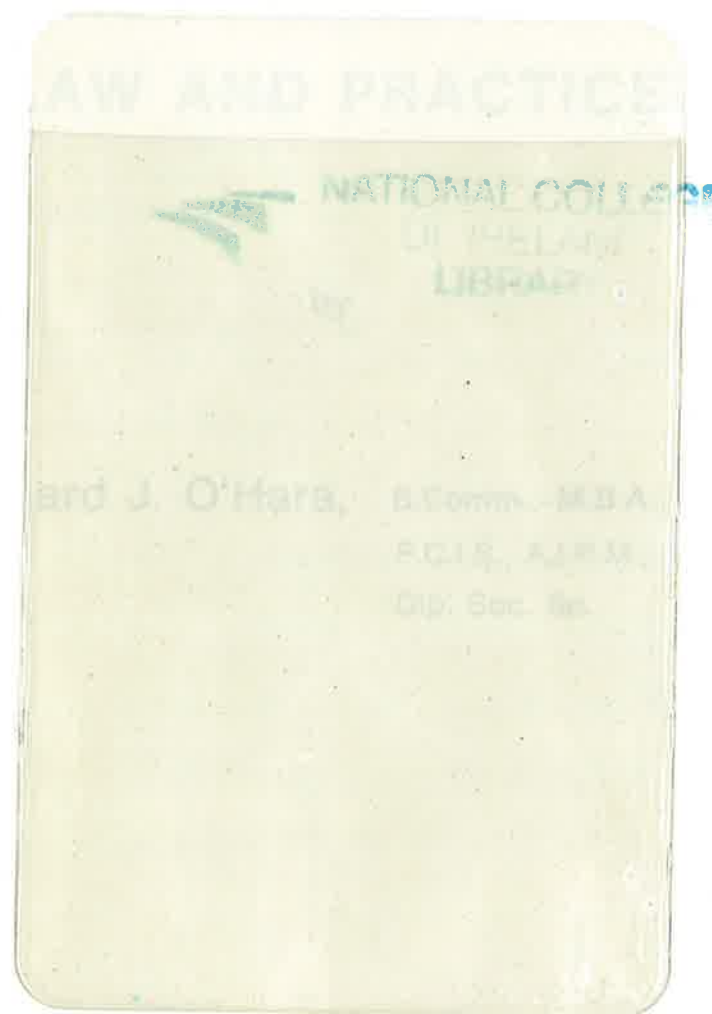

This agreement, which was concluded on 23 March 1978, had a duration of fifteen months and provided increases payable in two phases. The first phase increase was 8% of basic pay with a minimum of £3.50 a week and the second phase an increase of 2%.

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
